CAUTION: If you change the LDAP ID for testing, when the test user logs into the account the system will update the information on the profile and all the CARS the user is named on with their information, Name, email, etc. It will remain that way until the EID is changed back and the original user logs in again.

Things You Should Know

- **All internal users with an Honeywell ID account can get to the association screen but will still need to have an eCATS Profile to access and use eCATS.**
- **eCATS Administrators still need to manage and set up new eCATS users with eCATS Profiles.**
- **The eCATS Profile passwords are only used for the association and then are no longer needed. The reset password in eCATS does not do anything to the Honeywell ID password.**
- **On the eCATS home page is the change profile button, this will take you back to the select profile page allowing you to select another eCATS Profile to use.**
- **The association of eCATS Profiles is CASE SENSITIVE.**
